

Side Notes: "Silent Night" was composed in 1818 by Franz Gruber to words by Joseph Mohr. It was first sung on Christmas Eve in St. Nicholas parish church in the small town of Oberndorf, Austria. Because the church organ was damaged, it was first performed with guitar accompaniment. Of all the Christmas songs written, Silent Night is likely the best known across the world. I tried to keep this super simple so that anyone who plays piano could learn this arrangement and share it for the holidays.
