Side Note: "Deck the Halls" is a traditional Yuletide and New Years' carol. The tune is Welsh, dating back to the sixteenth century, and belongs to a winter carol titled "Nos Galan". In the eighteenth century, Mozart used the tune for a violin and piano duet. My first introduction to this song came as a kid when I saw the movie "A Christmas Story" and the Chinese Restaurant food servers entertained their guests by singing an out of tune "Fa Ra Ra Ra Ra" to the family in the movie. I remember thinking this was the funniest thing I had ever heard as a kid.

When I started this arrangement, I wanted to come up with something that was fun and showy to play. I ended up combining the rhythm from my arrangement of Called to Serve. It seemed to fit welll, and this is now one of my favorite pieces to perform during the holidays. Have fun with it, and don't hesitate to add a few extra notes or jazz it up even more when you play it!
