Side Notes: This carol came from the France in the 17th century. The lyrics tell the story of Jeanette and Isabella, two farmhands who find the baby Jesus and his mother in a stable. Excitedly they run to a nearby village to tell the people what they saw. To this day, on Christmas Eve in some areas of France, children dress as shepherds and milkmaids and carry torches and candles while singing the carol, on their way to Midnight Mass.
